• All horse must be registered with the AQHA. Each exhibitor must have current individual membership in the AQHA. No horses less than three years of age may be exhibited. Open division is for all registered AQHA horses 3 years and older, regardless of ownership or trainer. Amateur exhibitors must meet the AQHA criteria. The horse must be owned by the Amateur or a family member.

• To be eligible for points, one rider/one horse must enter all five classes. See Rule 478 in the AQHA Official Handbook of Rules and Regulations for further information

NO BUCKLES WILL BE AWARDED IN CLASSES WITH LESS THAN 3 ENTRIES

Winners under each judge will receive awards and ribbons.

Exhibitor with the highest composite score from the two judges will receive the Cow Palace Buckle provided there are at least 3 exhibitors in that class.

Grand Champions will be awarded the Cow Palace Cooler

Owners of horses entering the Versatility Ranch Horse and/or NRCHA classes must provide a Social Security or TIN number before you receive your show number. These are money classes and no checks will be issued without these numbers.

AQHA Performance Horse Halter classes. These are All Age classes. To enter, your horse must have earned a performance Register of Merit (ROM) in any division, including Racing, except showmanship. You will be **required to show proof of your horse's ROM** before you can enter these classes. This can be a copy of the horse's ROM certificate or a performance record computer print-out. You may not show in performance halter and traditional halter classes with the same horse on the same day in the same division.

**NOTE: You have 30 days from the last day of the show to resolve any
disputes over charges on your bill.

Reminder: if you fax an entry and are a no-show, you will be billed double for all classes, plus other fees noted on your fax.

All entries must be accompanied with a check and releases of liability signed by all horse handlers before any numbers are issued

All liability forms must be signed in the show office

ALL AQHA EXHIBITORS must show their Horse's Registration Papers and current AQHA Membership Card in his or her name only before showing. Copies are acceptable. Horse registration papers must show correct owner. If you are showing in performance halter, you must show proof of your horse's ROM. If you do not have a current AQHA membership card with you, in your name only, you can purchase one at the horse show. This will require a separate check. These fees are non-refundable. PCQHA memberships are also available at this show.

Signed transfers are not acceptable under any circumstances. Computer print-outs from the AQHA web site are not acceptable as proof of current Amateur or Open membership or ownership.

YOU MUST MAKE YOUR ENTRIES & SCRATCHES IN THE OFFICE.

No charge for scratches or class adds made in the office before your class. **Absolutely NO gate scratches or entries.** No shows will be charged double the class entry fee.

REFUNDS with vet or doctor certificate only before October 20. This must be on Doctor's official letterhead. Pre-paid entries will be refunded, **minus a \$35.00 office fee.** Sorry, cattle fees cannot be refunded once the cattle are ordered.

SELECT 50+ classes with less than 3 entries will be combined with Amateur.

To be eligible for Select classes, you must be 50 years old. You may show Select on your 50th birthday.

All Exhibitors are expected to know AQHA rules & are responsible for errors on entry forms. Please be sure you have entered the correct classes with the correct exhibitors. NRCHA exhibitors are expected to be familiar with NRCHA rules and regulations. If you have questions, we're here to help.
