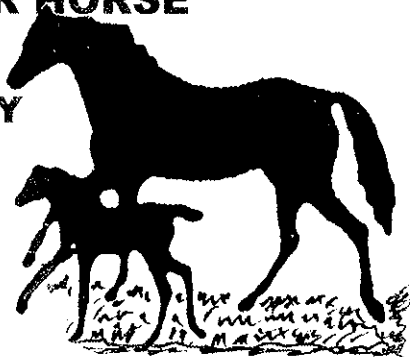

Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds is on Hwy 152 about 5 miles east of Watsonville.

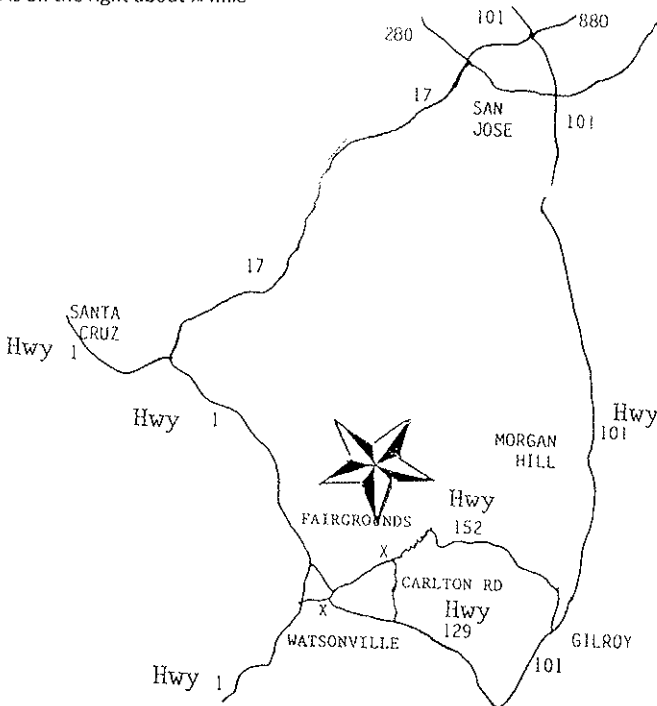
!! WARNING !! RV's and rigs pulling trailers

DO NOT take Hwy 152 between Gilroy and Watsonville.

It is very steep and very curvy.

Take Hwy 129 to Carlton Road to HWY 152, turn left

Fairgrounds is on the right about ¼ mile



- ❖ **NO STALLIONS** are allowed in **NOVICE** or **YOUTH** Classes
- ❖ **AQHA RULES** will prevail in all **AQHA** Classes
- ❖ **AQHA Novice Permits** are accepted for showing in **Novice** classes **ONLY**.
- ❖ You may obtain a permit at the horse show.

GATE SCRATCHES WILL NOT BE CREDITED**

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS TO KNOW THE AQHA RULES

If you have any questions, we're here to help

- ➔ **NO** Numbers will be issued until registration papers and AQHA memberships have been verified by the show secretary. Be sure your papers show the correct owner. **Signed transfers &/or computer print-outs are not acceptable** as proof of ownership or membership. All exhibitors must have a current AQHA membership in his or her name **ONLY**. **I MUST SEE YOUR CARD!** If you do not have one, you can purchase it at the horse show. Photo copies of registration papers and AQHA membership cards are acceptable. If your horse has been gelded and the papers still say Stallion, I can stamp the originals for you at the show at no charge.
- ➔ Select Amateurs may begin showing in the Select classes on their 50th birthday. You may **NOT** show in Select & Amateur with the same horse. You **MAY** show Novice and Select with the same horse.
- ➔ 11. & Under Walk/Jog classes are open to any breed of horse and there are no ownership or membership requirements. You may not enter classes calling for a lope or canter, but you may show in AQHA showmanship and/or halter classes in which case, all AQHA rules will apply.
- ➔ Roping jackpots are optional for Open & Amateur tie down & team roping. You are in the jackpot unless you declare otherwise before your first roping class. Jackpots will be paid daily to top two fast times, split 60/40. Checks will be mailed 4-5 weeks.
- ➔ **AQHA Performance Horse Halter**. Open & Amateur Stallions, Mares & Geldings and Youth Mares and Geldings. These are All Age classes. To enter, your horse must have earned a performance Register of Merit (ROM) in the Amateur, Youth, or Open divisions or an open Race ROM. **You will be required to show proof of your horse's ROM before you can enter these classes.** This can be a copy of your horse's ROM certificate or a computer print-out showing the date(s) when ROM was earned. You may not show the same horse in Performance Halter and traditional halter classes on the same day.

Please pick up your awards coupons at your arena right after your class.

Do not wait until you check out, you may forfeit them.

The office staff cannot keep track of your points, you must do that yourself

➔ **Arena 1 exhibitors**, come to the office for your coupons.

Coupon value: 1st place = \$10.00 • 2nd – 6th place = \$1.00

➔ PLEASE ☺

All horse trailers not being used as living quarters must be parked in the designated parking lot. All lanes must be kept clear for fairgrounds equipment, emergency vehicles, and drive-ins. No trailer parking between or in front of the barns.

Please plan ahead by ordering an extra tack room, if necessary

➤ **ABSOLUTELY NO ARRIVALS before Noon, Tuesday, July 20.**

➤ **STALL REFUNDS must be requested before July 22.**

➤ **NO stall refunds as of July 22.**

➤ **In the event a pre-entered horse or rider is sick or hurt, we will refund upon receipt of a Doctor or Veterinarian certificate, on their official letterhead, ONLY. No refunds for any other reason. Request must be submitted within 30 days of close of show.**

➤ **RETURNED CHECKS will be assessed \$50.00 and must be replaced with a cashier's check, money order, or cash, within 10 days of notification, or we will report it to AQHA and/or a collection agency. **No re-deposits.****

If your check has been returned to us, or any other show in the past, we reserve the right to require cash for payment of all fees.

ALL ENTRIES & SCRATCHES MUST BE MADE IN THE SHOW OFFICE. ENTRIES NOT MADE IN THE OFFICE WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE. GATE SCRATCHES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED or CREDITED. No shows will be charged DOUBLE.

The fair grounds require that ALL DOGS be on a leash and under the control of a responsible person. Animal control will patrol the grounds & impound loose dogs. Keep your dogs away from the food area, arena gates & horses.

Lettered Day Sheets to Reserve Champions

All horses must be shown all 4 days to be eligible for any awards

➤ Halter points will count but are not mandatory.

- You must show at least 3 classes per day for all rounds (except walk/jog & Green horse)
 - In case of a tie, horse with most halter points will be declared the winner.
 - Only AQHA classes will count for all rounds (except walk/jog).

CUTTING CLASSES DO NOT COUNT FOR ALL AROUNDS

➤ AQHA divisions may not be combined for awards. You may show in all divisions for which you are eligible. Points for circuit awards will be figured on a 9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 basis with 9 being the most points earned in a class. AQHA points are NOT added. If less than 9 horses in a class, points will decrease accordingly.

➤ **Hi-Point awards for CUTTING, ROPING, REINING, COWHORSE, & TRAIL** will be tallied from judges' cumulative scores, not placings.

➤ **Lettered Day Sheets** will be awarded to Hi-Point exhibitors in the Amateur, Green, Junior, & Senior Western Pleasure • Overall High Point Hunter Under Saddle horse & Overall High Point AQHA Green Horse.

➤ **Cutting: NCHA Trophy** to the overall highest scoring cutting horse. Lettered day sheet to reserve horse. **Silver buckles** awarded to the highest scoring horse in each of the remaining 5 divisions. Points tallied from judges' cumulative scores, not placings.

➤ **Working Cowhorse:** Silver buckle to the overall highest scoring cow horse of the Junior, Senior, Amateur, Select, Novice Amateur, or Youth divisions. The highest scoring horse in each of the remaining divisions wins a lettered day sheet. Points tallied from judges' cumulative scores, not placings.

➤ **Reining:** Silver buckle to the overall highest scoring reining horse of the Junior, Senior, Amateur, Select, Novice Amateur, or Youth divisions. The highest scoring horse in each of the remaining divisions wins a lettered day sheet. Points tallied from judges' cumulative scores, not placings.

➤ **Trail:** Silver buckle to the overall highest scoring horse of the Green, Junior, Senior, Amateur, Select, Novice Amateur, Novice Youth, Youth divisions or walk/jog divisions. The highest scoring horse in each of the remaining divisions wins a lettered day sheet. Points tallied from judges' cumulative scores, not placings.

➤ **Team Roping & Tie Down:** Open, Amateur & Youth. Silver Buckle to the horse with the highest cumulative scores of heading, heeling & tie down roping. Horses with the highest cumulative scores each of the other two divisions win a lettered day sheet.

➤ **A Special Select Amateur Buckle**, sponsored by **AQHB of SCV**, will be given in memory of **Don and Arlene O'Dell**.

All Around Buckles: Most halter points. 11 & Under: Coin toss.

Cutting Trophy & Buckles: Ride-off or coin toss. All other awards: Tie breaker judge
