## SHOW RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

**In all cases, decisions of Sun & Surf show management are final**

**MEMBERSHIP:** All exhibitors must present a current AQHA membership card in his/her name only. If you do not have one, it can be purchased at the show. All registration papers must be inspected before you receive a number. Photo-copies of cards and papers are accepted. Transfers or computer print-outs are not acceptable as proof of AQHA membership or ownership.

**CLOSING DATE:** All Pre-Entries must be **received by 5/1** to avoid late fees. Open checks are okay and will not be closed until the end of the circuit. Numbers will not be issued until all above information is provided.

**STALLS & TACKROOMS** must be pre-paid. No arrivals before 5/15 without prior approval. Early arrivals will be charged an extra \$50 per horse/per day.

**Prior arrangements MUST be made for early arrivals. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

No stalls reserved without payment or secured with an open check

**ENTRY FORM PROCEDURE:** Exhibitors are responsible for errors on the entry forms. Be sure to show correct exhibitor for each class. The entry form, mailed or faxed must be complete with names, address, zip code and phone number. Include copies of registration papers and AQHA membership cards. **Be sure to sign the release.** **Late Entries** will be accepted at the show with a **\$25.00** per horse late fee. Please make adds at the show at least 2 classes prior. No penalty for added classes or scratches if you have pre-entered classes.

**ALL CLASS ADDS & SCRATCHES MUST BE MADE IN THE SHOW OFFICE.**

Gate scratches will not be credited

**RETURNED CHECKS** will be charged **\$50.00** and must be made good with a cashiers check, money order, or cash, within 10 days of notification, or the matter will be turned over to AQHA for further action. **There Will Be No Re-Deposits.**

If you have had a check returned at this show, be prepared to pay cash.

**CONFLICTS:** Please inform the gate person if you have a conflict.

**AQHA GREEN HORSE:** Classes are open to all age horses who have not earned more than 10 points or \$1000 in that class as of January 1 of current year.

**GELDING OWNERS,** if you have not had your papers changed, bring the originals to the show and have them stamped by the show secretary. There is no fee.

**REFUNDS:** All requests for refunds must be made in writing. Requests made prior to 5/16 will receive a 100% refund. As of 5/16 we will require a veterinary certificate, on his/her business letterhead, and deduct \$25.00 per horse. All refunds will be at the discretion of Sun & Surf show management. **No stall refunds if we have to rent portables.**

**FAXED ENTRIES** are considered official entries and as such you are responsible for all fees and classes noted. If you are a no show, you will be billed for said fees.

**PARKING** is available in designated areas only. Violators will be issued a citation and could be towed at owner's expense. NO PARKING between the barns. Platinum sponsors will have designated reserved parking spaces.

**ANIMAL CONTROL:** All pets **must be leashed** and under the control of a responsible person at all times. No pets will be allowed in the preparation, riding or food areas.

**\$150 fine!! DO NOT LET YOUR DOGS RUN LOOSE!! Animal control will be called.**

**VETERINARIAN** Information will be posted in the office. Vet will be on call.

**AQHA Performance Horse Halter:** These are All Age classes. To enter, your **horse** must have earned a performance Register of Merit (ROM). **You will be required to show proof of your horse's ROM before you can enter these classes.** Proof can be a copy of the ROM certificate or a computer print out showing date and type of ROM. You may not show the same horse in Performance Halter and traditional halter classes on the same day in the same division.

**You have 30 days from the close of this show to dispute any charges or points.**

**After 30 days the books are closed and there can be no changes.**

**Circuit Awards – Silverado Silver Buckles**

All exhibitors are required to show to 6 judges for all awards

**♫ 60 + Super Select ♫**

Special Sun & Surf Silverado Buckle to the overall high point sixty and over exhibitor in the Select Amateur classes for the circuit. Circuit awards will go to each Select Amateur exhibitor who is 60 years or "better."

**All Around Awards:** Horses must compete in at least 3 classes to each judge. All Around Awards will go to the winners in each division. Points will be tallied on a 9-8-7 basis with 9 being the maximum points to be earned under one judge. If less than 9 entries, points will decrease accordingly. AQHA points will not be added. Halter is required for Junior & Senior Horses, Youth, and Amateur. It is not required for Novices, Walk/Jog & Green Horse.

\*\*All Youth & Novice Youth classes will be 18 & under, however, for the All Around, Sun & Surf will break out the 13 & under and 14 & over champion exhibitors. (this does not apply to circuit awards)

Silver Buckles will go to the overall champion Open & Amateur Halter Stallions and the overall Champion Open, Amateur & Youth Halter Mares & Halter Geldings. Points figured on Grand & Reserve champion standings, not class placings. Buckles **will not** be awarded in each age division halter class. High Point Performance Halter Champions will also receive a Silverado Buckle. Silver Buckles will be awarded to all other AQHA & 11 & Under circuit champions.

11 & Under Walk/Jog Classes carry no AQHA or PCQHA approvals. No requirements for ownership or memberships. Open to all breeds. May not show in any classes requiring lope or canter at this horse show. You may show in the AQHA halter and/or showmanship if all AQHA registration & membership requirements are met.

Sun & Surf Non-Pro Trail Classic: \$1000.00 added is open to all breeds & Non-Pros, including Youth. Proof of non-pro status is required. **Silverado Buckles** to Champion & Reserve champion. There will be 4 judges. The entry fee is \$150 and \$100 of each entry will go into the jackpot. Checks will be mailed in 6-8 weeks. Judge's low scores will be dropped.

NSBA Futurities are open to all breeds. NSBA membership is required. There will be 4 judges. 60% of each entry will go into the jackpot. Checks will be mailed in 6-8 weeks. Judge's low scores will be dropped. NSBA memberships & passes will be available in office. Champions in each futurity will receive a **Silverado Silver Buckle and a \$250 certificate from Woods Western.**
